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## 2017 Theme: "A Candy Cane Christmas"

All entries must be in good taste. Participants are Highly Encouraged to light-up their entries, as **winners** will be selected from among the lit entries. Winners will be chosen during lineup so they can be recognized during the parade.

Must be 21 years of age or older to drive in the parade. Any person driving in the parade must hold a valid driver's license and have liability insurance. Please have these document with you on parade day. The Azle Police Department will be checking these items.

### Rules and Guidelines

1. You must check-in at the registration table located on the playground of Azle Elementary between 4:00-5:30 p.m. The playground is located in the back of Azle Elementary off of Central Drive.
2. Begin check in and lining up at 4:00 p.m. Judging will take place at 5:00 p.m. Parade begins promptly at 6:00 p.m.
3. Late arrivals will be placed at the end of the parade– NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. Entry numbers must be clearly visible to be eligible for awards. Entry numbers will be distributed upon arrival.
5. Vehicle drivers must hold a valid driver's license, have liability insurance, and be at least 21 years of age. These documents will be checked by the Azle Police Department– NO EXCEPTIONS.
6. Vehicles must be large enough for all riders to remain seated inside the perimeter of the vehicle.
7. Vehicles are not permitted to stop on the parade route and must remain 30 feet behind preceding entry/float.
8. Participants must be 18 years of age or older to ride in an ATV, go-cart, or other recreational motorized vehicle.
9. **Throwing candy from moving vehicles is strictly prohibited. Throwing candy poses a safety issue for small children in the crowd. Anyone seen throwing candy from vehicles will be removed by the Azle Police Department.**
10. Walking parade participants will be allowed to hand out candy to the crowd. You must be handing the candy, not throwing it.
11. No off-loading or on-loading of parade participants permitted along the parade route.
12. The Azle Area Chamber Santa is the only Santa allowed in the parade. No other Santa's are allowed.

### Parade Route

Line up will begin at 4:00 p.m. behind Azle Elementary. The parade coordinator will inform you where your designated waiting area is located. The parade will begin promptly at 6:00 p.m.

The parade will enter Green Way from the playground of Azle Elementary and travel to Church Street. At Church Street the parade will make a right turn, then another right turn onto Main Street. This is the official start of the parade.

The parade will travel down Main Street to Industrial Avenue then turn right. Another right will be made on Central Drive bringing the parade to an end where it began, behind Azle Elementary.

### After The Parade

Parade participants, if minors, should remain with their group behind Azle Elementary until a parent or guardian arrives to pick them up. The designated waiting and pick up area will be at the check-in table on the playground.
