Who are the Chamber Ambassadors?

The Ambassadors are a group of dynamic business professionals who are Azle Area Chamber of Commerce members. They function as a public relations arm of the Chamber.

Purpose:

This volunteer group exists to support and assist the Azle Area Chamber of Commerce, its staff, board, and membership. The Ambassadors are the Chamber's hosts; welcoming guests, providing information, creating a welcoming atmosphere, and volunteering at chamber events.

Qualifications for Prospective Ambassadors:

Being an Ambassador requires participation. To qualify, members must have at least three months of active participation in the AACoC and have attended at least three chamber-related events.

A prospective member must return a completed application and be in good standing with the Chamber to be considered for the program.

Prospective Ambassadors are presented to the full membership if the Ambassador is present at a monthly meeting. Election as an Ambassador requires a majority of these present (quorum required.)

To maintain membership in the Ambassador program, participants must remain members in good standing with the Chamber.
